Entry Phase



TEACHERS ENTER THE CONTEST

Aug. 29 - Nov. 14

Teachers apply to the contest by submitting the entry form describing their students' project due Oct. 20. Visit our judging criteria for more information.

Phase 1



STATE FINALISTS ANNOUNCED

Dec. 5 - Jan. 11

Judges will evaluate the entry forms and announce up to 300 State Finalists. State Finalists will be selected to receive a \$2,500 prize package to be distributed by Samsung.

Phase 2



STATE WINNERS ANNOUNCED

Jan. 30 - Mar. 7

Judges will evaluate the entry forms and announce up to 50 State Winners. State Winners will be selected to receive a \$12,000 prize package to be redeemed on DonorsChoose.org, plus a \$2,000 Samsung video kit for the video portion of their project. A Samsung employee mentor will be assigned to the team at this stage. See Official Rules for details.

Phase 3



NATIONAL FINALISTS ANNOUNCED

Mar. 26

Judges will evaluate video submissions and announce the 10 National Finalists that will move forward in the competition. National Finalists win \$50,000 in Samsung technology and classroom materials from DonorsChoose.org.



COMMUNITY AND EMPLOYEE CHOICE VOTING

Mar. 26 - April 16

The public will vote for their favorite projects from the top ten National Finalists on social media from Mar. 5 - Apr. 21. One Community Choice Winner and one Employee Choice Winner will be announced at the National Winner reveal.

Phase 4



FINAL JUDGING EVENT

Apr. 29 & 30

The top ten National Finalists will pitch to a panel of judges. At the end of the event, judges will announce one Community Choice Winner, one Employee Choice Winner, and three National Winners.
